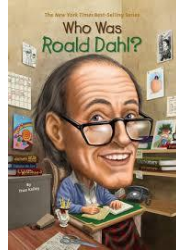


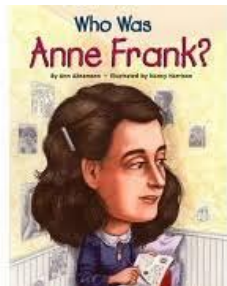
## Summer Reading List for Rising Third Graders!

1. Read the book, "Who was Roald Dahl?" by True Kelley.



2. From the "Who was" series, choose one special female to read about.



Some examples:

After you read, write 4-5 sentences about the woman of the second book you read. We would really like each student to write their sentences on their own, without help from parents or older siblings. The sentences can be written on a looseleaf piece of paper with their name in the upper right hand corner. The students should tell us about the woman they read about, but there is no criteria about what they tell us, as long as it was information they learned from the book. It will be a great way for us to see how well they write!
